

## **Al Roth Memorial Scholarship**

**Deadline for turning in a scholarship application is July 15<sup>th</sup>.**

This is a memorial scholarship in the name of Alfred Roth, a long time conference center friend and supporter of CBCC and Ecola Bible School, offered to CBCC summer staff or conference assistants who will be attending Ecola Bible School in the fall. The following guidelines will apply.

- Up to one \$1,000 scholarship and two \$500 scholarships awarded each summer. A total of up to \$2,000 in scholarships would be given out each summer for five years.
- To be eligible, summer staff or conference assistants must have worked for CBCC at least 9 weeks of the summer.
- Participants will complete a brief one page scholarship application which will outline their level of financial need, their reason for attending Ecola, and what they have gained from serving on staff at CBCC. Awards will be determined by the CBCC scholarship committee and given to the summer staff or CA who most embody a spirit of service and desire to grow in God's Word. In some instances, the scholarship committee may request a personal interview with a scholarship applicant.
- Recipients of the Al Roth Memorial Scholarship will be asked to write a "thank you" note to Dorothy Roth, Al's widow who established the memorial fund.
- Awards will be paid directly to Ecola Bible School at the beginning of the Fall term but would not be transferable to any other college or secondary school. If a scholarship winner does not attend Ecola, the money would either stay in the scholarship fund or be distributed to the other scholarship winners.
