

Oregon Food Handler Permit

All summer staff must have a valid Oregon food handler permit.

Staff with a valid Oregon food handler permit must bring a copy of their permit to orientation.

Staff without a valid Oregon food handler permit must take the test online prior to arrival and bring a copy of their permit to orientation.

To take the Oregon Food Handler training online and receive your food handler permit, follow these procedures:

1. Go to www.ora.org and click on the link "Food Handler Online"
2. Create a "New Student" account.
3. Under the section "Identification", click on "Type Of ID" and choose which ID you will enter: Oregon driver's license, DMV ID, or military ID.
 - Under "Company Name" type "Cannon Beach Conference Center"
 - Under "Store # or ID" don't type anything.
 - Under "Supervisor", type "Paul Knoch"
 - Under "Phone Number" type 503-436-1501
 - Under "Address" type 289 N. Spruce Cannon Beach OR 97110
9. Once registered, study the online food handler course and take the test.
10. To pay for the course, enter the code: 168093 (This code will charge the cost of the test to the CBCC employer account). **Please do not give this code to other people.**
11. After successfully passing the test, print out the certificate and present it to human resources.

Your new Oregon food handler permit is valid for three years so remember to save your "new student" account ID and password. If you lose your food handler permit, you can log in and print out a new one.
